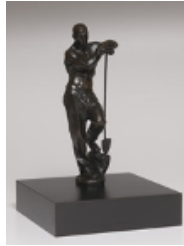


JEWES IN THE AMERICAS

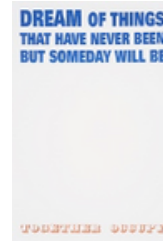

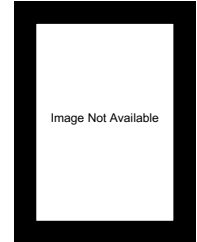

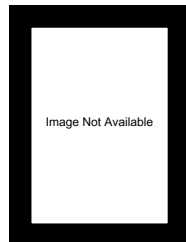

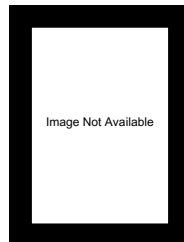
